

Microbusiness Grant Portal Reopens

On August 11, the County of Santa Clara and the Enterprise Foundation reopened the portal to accept additional applications for the Microbusiness Grant Program, which grants \$2,500 to qualified businesses affected by COVID-19. The application portal will remain open until the funds are exhausted.

To qualify for the \$2,500 grant, microbusinesses must have made less than \$50,000 in total revenue (not net) in each of the last three years, have fewer than five employees, was negatively affected by COVID-19, was open in 2019, and in operation in 2022.
